Dear Developer,

Thank you for purchasing the SCO XENIX 386 Development System Update S. This Update has all the new features and enhancements included in the SCO XENIX 386 Development System Release 2.3. Some of the more significant features are:

- Microsoft Version 4.85 386 compiler
- Microsoft Version 5.1 286 compiler
- UNIX 5.3 C preprocessor
- Full support of prototypes and pragmas
- UNIX 5.3 termcap curses
- New libraries that support features new to SCO XENIX Release 2.3
- Operating System such as select

Since the SCO XENIX 386 Development System Release 2.3 currently ships with SCO CGI Release 1.0.1, a revised version of SCO CGI is not required as part of this update. For development on streams-based modules, the SCO Streams System is needed. It includes necessary operating system modules and development libraries.

Before installing Update S you should first remove any existing version of the SCO XENIX 386 Development System. Then, manually remove:

<code>/etc/perms/soft</code>	<code>/etc/perms/dsmd</code>
<code>/etc/soft.perms</code>	<code>/etc/dsmd.perms</code>

After these files have been removed, the user should proceed with normal installation as discussed in the accompanying documentation.
